



The Myriad Centre is a registered charitable organisation providing specialist day respite care and support for young adults with profound and multiple learning disabilities (PMLD), and support for their carers/families, from across Worcestershire and surrounding areas.



We deliver a range of care, therapies, and activities, all delivered in a safe and stimulating environment. These include music and arts therapy, hydrotherapy, physiotherapy, rebound therapy (which uses a trampoline), and a full programme of fun and fulfilling days out.



The young adults we support are amongst the most disadvantaged and vulnerable in our community, with conditions that include developmental delay, severe physical disabilities, profound learning disabilities, autism, cerebral palsy and challenging mental health conditions.



We currently support up to 16 young adults and their families/carers every weekday.



Up to 50 young adults with PMLD in Worcestershire may need the specialist services of a centre like Myriad over the next three-to five years.



Worcestershire has a higher proportion of young people with a learning disability who need daily care than the national average.



It costs £67,700 per month to deliver our services, that's £812,400 per year.



The charity was established in 2007.



We rely on public donations and grants to deliver all the enriching, and enjoyable therapies and activities that we provide to help improve our clients' physical and mental wellbeing.
