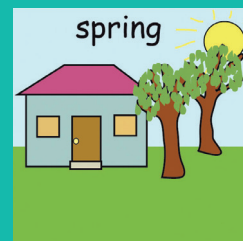

Visitors had the opportunity to explore our facilities and learn about our services in a warm, welcoming environment.

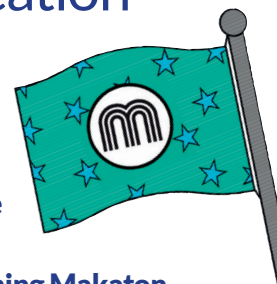
Thank you to our dedicated family ambassadors who shared their personal experiences, providing insights for newcomers considering the Myriad Centre. Thanks

Learning Makaton: Our Journey to Communication Excellence

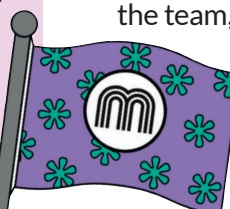
As we move towards becoming a Centre of Excellence for Communication, all our staff are learning Makaton - a form of sign language specifically for communicating with those with Learning Disabilities.
